Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd in each jump height of each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs may receive placement ribbons without qualifying.

Fast track dogs will only get qualifying ribbons at the Beginners/Games I and Intermediate/Games II levels. One High in Trial will be offered each day to one dog/handler team that competes in all classes per day. HIT to be determined by highest score, then fastest time if score is tied.

Running Order

Standard classes – Superior, Intermediate, Beginner

Games classes – Games III, Games II, Games I, except in cases where all levels can run the same Games course.

Jump heights will correspond to the height running order per day. Saturday: small to large; Sunday: large to small.

A warm up area, consisting of regulation TDAA equipment, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacle Familiarization will be provided on Saturday and Sunday mornings 30 minutes prior to judging for all dogs and handlers. **No toys or treats may be used in the ring during familiarization.**

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in designated areas, e.g., the warm-up area and the designated off leash area.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- At the handler's option, the dog may wear a flat (buckle or quick release) collar with or without tags or wear adornments, clothing, ties or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring. Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9TDAA.com.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors who do not clean up after their dog will be subject to dismissal with no refund of their entry fees.
- No dogs shall be left at the trial site overnight.
- TDAA and Cool Critters are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or un-prescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the building the day of a TDAA event.

Vendors

- Great Pyrenees Rescue will be available as a food vendor for the weekend. There are also fast food restaurants within a short driving distance. Volunteers will get \$2 coupons for each class worked redeemable for either the food vendor or future Cool Critters trials.
- There is some space for vendors and we would love to have you. Please contact Ileana. Vendors will be charged a \$25 donation to our DACOF fund.

Eligibility

- This trial is open to all dogs under 17" and over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.
- Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. There is a registration form included in this premium, or you can register the first day of the trial. TDAA rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at www.k9tdaa.com.

Jump Height Table

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge.

Class Information

Standard Class

- **Beginning Agility** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from another organization.
- **Intermediate Agility** – Dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- **Superior Agility** – Dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

- **Games I** – All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations
- **Games II** – Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.
- **Games III** – Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

FEO (FOR EXHIBITION ONLY) – TDAA now offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last at their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. No treats or food allowed. FEO will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO participants cannot repeat any obstacles; no training is permitted in the ring.

HANDICAP HANDLER EXEMPTION – Handlers who have been given handicap status by their home state will be given additional time to run standard courses and time based games. See TDAA rules for additional information. (www.k9tdaa.com) This additional time is in addition to any exemption given to the handler's dog due to Veteran status. Proof of handicap shall be a copy of the handler's disabled parking tag or official documentation provided with the entry or presented at check-in.

Games Classes

The following are some brief descriptions of the games offered at this trial. We encourage you to enter the games classes even if they seem unfamiliar to you – we are sure that you will have lots of fun!

Judge's briefing on day of trial supersedes any previous briefings. The judge will provide a thorough briefing to exhibitors and hard copies of the complete rules and qualifying requirements will be available. Example briefings are available on TDAA's Web site at www.k9tdaa.com.

- **Time Warp** – The object of this game is to run the required course as fast as possible without faults. All obstacles must be completed. Scoring is time plus faults minus bonus. Faults are missed contacts and dropped bars. Refusals and off course are not faulted.
- **Colors** – The Colors course is made up of two relatively equal numbered sequences. The handler must select one sequence to be completed by the dog.
- **Power and Speed** – Each handler and dog runs a course that is split into two sections: Power and Speed. The power course will contain no more than 7 obstacles, including 3 contact obstacles, 12 weave poles, and a max of 3 spread hurdles. The speed section contains a straightforward sequence of jumps only.
- **Double or Nothing** – This is a strategy game. It is similar to gamblers in that there is an opening period to gather points. There are two gambles on course. When the whistle blows, the team performs the first gamble and, if successful, the team can go on to attempt the second gamble. If they fail at the second gamble they lose all gamble points; if they get it they double their gamble points. This game is scored points, then time.
- **Minuet** – The team performs a numbered sequence in a continuous loop during the allotted time.

- **All pre-entries must be RECEIVED by 6:00 p.m., February 8, 2012.** To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date, and accompanied by the correct fees made payable to **Cool Critters**. You must file a separate entry form for each dog entered (i.e., only one dog per form).
- Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on an official TDAA Agility Entry Form, one dog per entry form.
- Photocopied entries without the TDAA Agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.
- All fees must be paid in U.S. funds. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted in the trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 per run of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification from a Veterinarian of such claim for refund by letter (not email) before February 8, 2012.
- **Your TDAA height card is *not* required at check-in. However, if you enter your dog at a height lower than his eligible height, then any qualifying scores will be forfeit.**

Fast Track Program

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then qualifies again in Intermediate. It is also possible to move up from Games I to Games III on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Games I and then qualifies again in Games II, or if a dog scores enough points in Games I to qualify for Games III.

A qualifying score in the lower class is required to move up to the next higher class. You must submit a copy of title certificates for each dog. **Fast tracked dogs are not eligible for placement or title ribbons in the lower levels**, but are eligible to receive Q ribbons.

Please mark each that apply and submit \$8.00 with this form. Payment of the \$8.00 is no guarantee that your dog will qualify at the lower level (though he will have multiple chances at each), and is non-refundable. **The Fast Track fee must be paid for this trial even if it was paid for a previous trial.**
